Hello Beautiful Friends,

Like the morning dew that rests upon the grass, the summer months evaporate so rapidly. I enjoyed my time in India, while travels and meetings reduced the time with my family it did not diminish the joy of my stay. I am most thankful for the opportunity to recharge while basking in the love of family and friends. The end of summer is equally a wonderful time in the life of everyone. The peace and productivity of August give way to the exuberance and enthusiasm of the Fall.

I am overflowing with anticipation about this year at Christ the King. We will continue to welcome our longtime friends and well-wishers, returning retreatants, new retreatants, hosted groups and visitors, while making new friends every day. As the new season begins the lyrics of a song come to mind, "this is a day of new beginnings, time to remember and move on...to show and share what love can do...our God is making all things new."

*We Walk with Jesus all the way.* The life-style and the ministry of Jesus were always characterized by two specific qualities: **Presence and Accompaniment**. One of the significant points that we see in Jesus' formation of His disciples is that He was always with them. When they were tossed up in the storms of the sea (in the difficult moments of their life), when they argued amongst themselves as to who would be the greatest in the Kingdom (personality clashes based on Egoism),

when they betrayed and denied Him (ingratitude and infidelity) or when they slept, while He experienced deep sorrow and agony in the garden (sheer indifference and an "I don't care" attitude), JESUS WAS PRESENT WITH THEM AND ACCOMPANIED THEM, instructing them, teaching them and redefining the meaning of their life.

The lesson from Jesus was that even when the disciples were not willing to be with Him and go with Him, He was willing to be present with them and accompany them in every eventuality of their lives.

Every sincere relationship demands personal presence and accompaniment. By being present to a person constantly, you enter in to a heart to heart relationship. It is easy to create an impact on others by our rhetoric and random dialogues. But true relationship, mutual trust and confidence, only develop when we know the smallness and greatness of the other, when we are able to live out our own smallness and fragilities in encountering the other.

Christ the King continues to provide an atmosphere where we recognize Christ's presence and renew our relationship with God, oneself and other.

My sincere gratitude, love and prayerful wishes to everyone, the benefactors, staff and volunteers, who contribute to make Christ the King a better place.

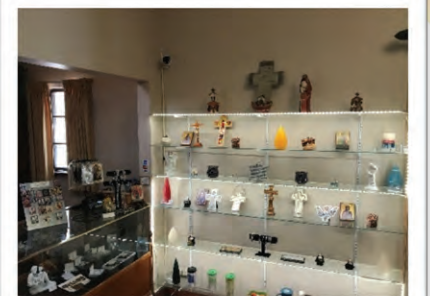
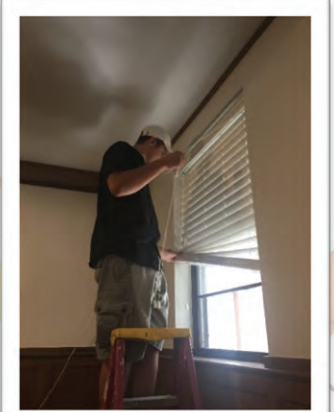
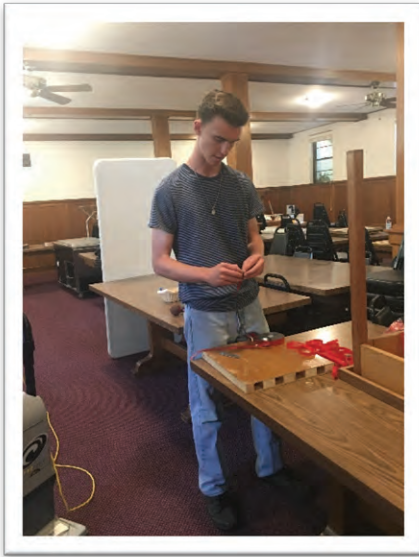
Thanks to the generosity of our donors we have been able to give many areas in the Center a facelift.

Thank you to everyone who attended and who purchased raffle tickets and made donations.

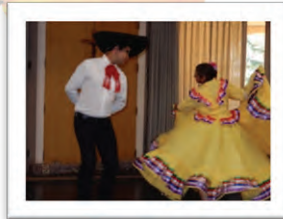

# Our Lady of Fatima Crowning Mass and Consecration of the Diocese

On May 13, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, over 300 people attended Mass to join Bishop Cotta as he crowned the statue of Our Lady of Fatima and consecrated the Diocese of Sacramento to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

In his homily, Bishop Cotta explained how the statue, an exact replica of the original, was gifted to him in 2014 by Sister Julia Fonseca. Her wish was that the people of Sacramento who could not make the pilgrimage to Portugal, could visit a shrine in their local area. Bishop Cotta also placed relics of the newly canonized saints, Jacinta and Francisco Marto, two of the children of Fatima, at the feet of Our Lady.

Mass was concelebrated by Father Jim Strommer CP, Superior of the Christ the King Community and Father Clemente Barron CP, Director of Hispanic Ministry. The Bishop was assisted by Deacon Dennis Gorsuch and Server, Brady Lendewig.



The Gold filigree crown was presented to Bishop Cotta by Evan Anderson. Ladies of the Christ the King Guild took up the Offertory, Bill Swars proclaimed the Word and Leanne Etcheverry led the singing, ably accompanied by Leona Meyer.

The lay participants were coordinated by our resident sacristan, Chris Swars.

The Passionist Community at Christ the King feel especially honored to have been entrusted as the custodians of the statue and each day pilgrims visit the special shrine which has been constructed adjacent to the Chapel for people to pay homage to Our Lady.

We look forward to our Marian Rosary Procession on Saturday October 14.

## *May the Passion of Jesus Christ be Always in our Hearts*

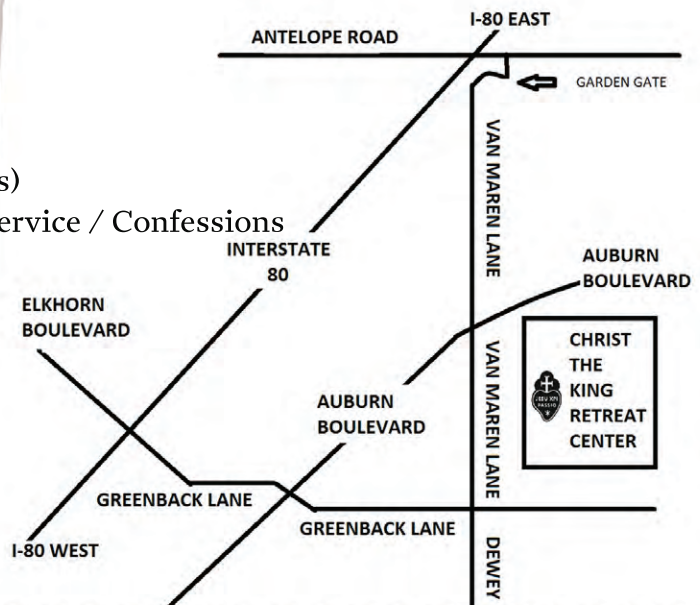
