
CHRIST THE KING SPRING 2021 NEWSLETTER

Dear Friends,

As I reminisce about my childhood, one memory has stuck with me. It had to do with riding the school bus for the first time. My mother prepared me well; took me to the spot where the bus would drop me off; showed me where she would stand to wait for me; asked me if I felt ok; and I remember thinking, "I can do this." The day came. I hopped onto the bus, I took a seat, and as we prepared to leave the school parking lot, I remember being a little nervous. What if I missed the bus stop? What if my mom wasn't there to receive me? A few unknowns, but overall, nothing that would deter me from hopping off the bus at the right moment. It was time, the second-to-last stop. The bus driver looked at me and told me it was my stop. I looked back at her and said she wasn't right. I said "no". I refused to get off the bus, because to me, I didn't see the spot where my mom was standing, I didn't see the sidewalk that looked familiar. And so, I stayed on the bus until it returned to the school. At which point, my mother met us and asked what happened. The bus driver shared about my hesitation. As I rode home with my mom, she pointed to me where she had been standing, she showed me the sidewalk, and it was at that moment I realized I had been looking out of the "wrong" side of the bus.

As I share this memory, I reflect on how God prepares us in our lives and shows us His Love. There are those times we are sure; we feel confident and we KNOW God. We follow His path He's laid out for us and it feels good. Then there are the times when we are challenged or questioned, and our faith wavers and we feel like we do not KNOW God. Sometimes, we end up back at our original location, and we learn from the experience. Other times, we take the leap of faith and go where we have never been before. Inevitably, we continue.

One year ago, our Retreat Center was shaken. Our path was deterred and our vision re-imagined. We didn't have a clear idea of how the pandemic would affect us. In fact, we didn't even think it would last a year. However, we've very cautiously stayed the course, continued with our Passionist program offerings, kept our grounds open, and reached out in the ways of technology, email, and mailings. We've made it through to another Springtime. This time, the news about coming back "in person" is something we all look forward to hearing. As we move into this year, we pray for God's continued guidance and blessings. May you and your loved ones be showered with God's love during this Springtime and beyond.
