#### Dear Friends,

As I write this letter, I've been suffering from lower back pain. Maybe you are familiar with how back pain or other body pains are. Bending, sitting, standing, laying down, it all feels painful and uncomfortable. It's definitely nothing to brag about and something I don't want to identify with. But somehow, when it comes up in conversation, there's a sense of empathy I receive. Apparently, I'm not alone.

These days, finding one's identity is hard to do with all the distractions and challenges being brought to us. Finding a community where we belong and feel supportive can also be challenging.

As a Passionist family, we identify with our Sign. The heart shaped Sign focuses on love. Above the heart is a cross, the greatest sign of God's love. Inside the heart is written Jesu (Jesus' name in Hebrew) Xpi (The beginning of the word Christ, in Greek) and Passio (Latin for Passion). Beneath the words, are three nails which represent the ones fixed to Jesus on the Cross. It's the sign that brings us back to our founder St. Paul of the Cross. It's through this Sign, that we are reminded about our foundation to keep as a constant reminder the Passion of Jesus Christ. It's a sign that has survived generations.

In the past couple years, our retreat center has gone through quite a change. The first year of the pandemic we switched to online formats for many of our Passionist programs. And now in our second year, we opened our doors and planned for in-person programs, but the pandemic continued to loom in the background.

Our retreat team, staff and vowed Passionists stayed strong to our foundation that your spiritual growth and connection to God during these days with the pandemic is very important. Our mission to be inclusive and at the foot of the cross with those who are suffering continues to lead us, here at CTK. We believe your spiritual health and physically being on our sacred grounds is not an option but rather a life source. We truly are here for you.


