Dear Friends,

On Saturday, October 4, 2025, we will gather to celebrate a milestone in our shared journey—our Diamond Jubilee: "Let it Shine! Celebrating 75 Years as Pilgrims of Hope and Light!" This special evening will not only honor our 75th anniversary but also welcome three distinguished guests: Bishop Jaime Soto, Auxiliary Bishop Rey Bersabel, and Fr. David Colhour, C.P., our Passionist Provincial Superior.

Christ the King's story began in 1945 when inspired laymen from the Holy Name Union joined Passionist priests to establish a place of spiritual renewal in Citrus Heights. By 1950, the first retreat house opened, welcoming men seeking rest and hope. Over time, our mission grew to embrace women's retreats and some of California's earliest Recovery retreats for Alcoholics Anonymous—offering healing and new beginnings to many.

Today, as we reflect on 75 years of grace, we also look to the horizon. Our retreat center now welcomes over 80 retreatants at a time, and we remain deeply committed to Catholic men's and women's retreats, expanding our Recovery ministries, and growing outreach to the Spanish-speaking Catholic community. We're also hosting high school groups and new retreats for young adults and families, widening the embrace of our Passionist charism of compassion, hospitality, and hope.

Our Jubilee is more than an anniversary—it is a renewed call to listen to Christ, to meet the needs of our time with open hearts.

Inspired by our Catholic retreat theme this year, "Listen, Jesus Is Calling! – A Pilgrimage of Our Hearts," rooted in the promise of Matthew 18:20—"For where two or three are gathered together in my name, I am in the midst of them"—we come together to hear His voice in prayer and reflection. On this sacred pilgrimage, during our weekend retreats, we invite everyone to draw closer to the heart of Christ and to one another, discovering unity, deeper faith, and conversion.

A retreat center without retreatants and volunteers is just a building. But through your faith, your presence, and the dedication of our Passionist community and staff, it becomes holy ground—where countless people find healing, rediscover faith, and encounter God's merciful love.

Your prayers and continued support are the foundation for our future—so that together, even more hearts might experience the miracles God longs to share, especially with those most in need of His love and mercy.

The Passionist Community and the staff of Christ the King pray that you feel God's abiding love and grace as we step forward into the next 75 years—together as pilgrims of hope and light.

News from Hispanic Ministry

This past year has provided us with invaluable opportunities to build and support the Hispanic Community through various spiritual formation courses. We have actively worked to create effective plans for Christian life, explored feminine spirituality, and engaged in meaningful Mass, Adoration, and fellowship during our Passionist Mondays.

Our Lenten journey has been particularly impactful, as we organized a day of reflection, engaged in the Stations of the Cross every Friday, and commemorated Good Friday by celebrating the Last Seven Words, Adoration of the Holy Cross, and the Rosary to Our Sorrowful Mother. Additionally, we held our first Day of Retreat for Women, and conducted our inaugural overnight silent retreat.

In response to the challenges faced by the immigrant community, we have committed to daily prayers of the Stations of the Cross for and about immigrants. This journey has brought together both challenges and blessings, each serving to enrich our Mission and deepen our Passionist Charism.
